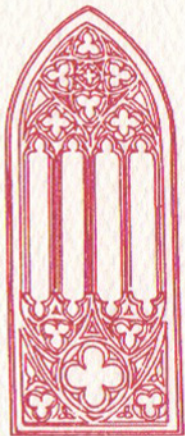

of sun

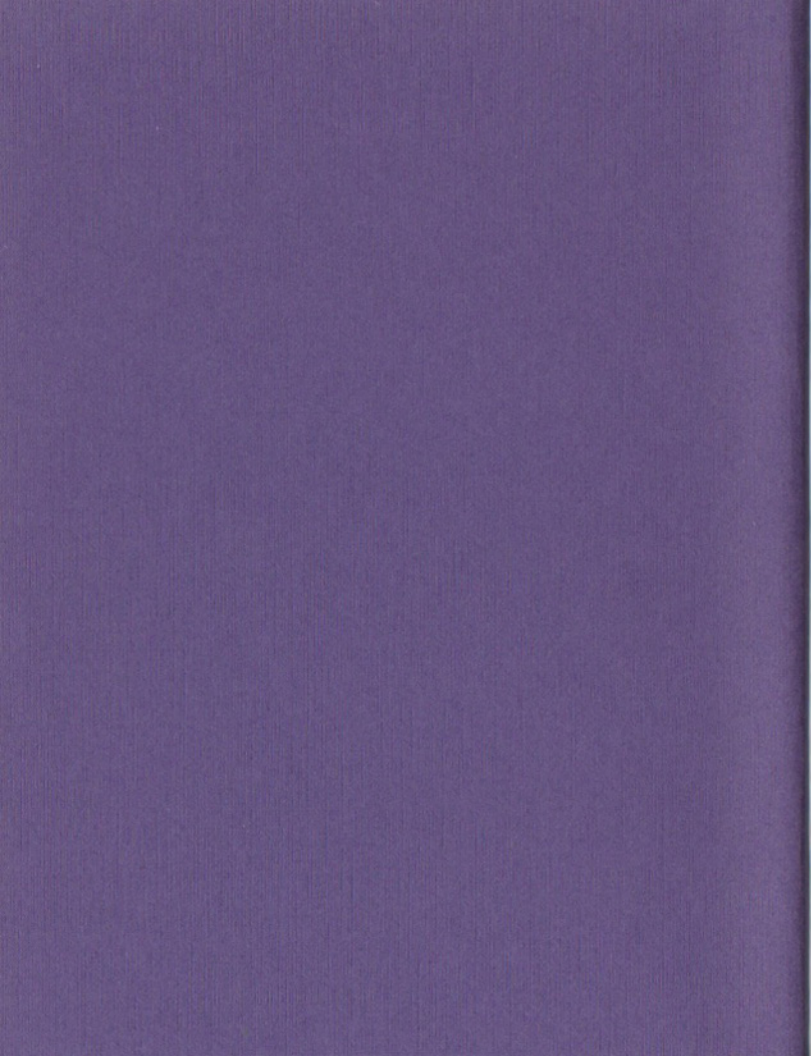
between Hail Marys
